In consideration for being granted access to a non-public area of the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History (Museum) to view certain boxes and other storage containers, as directed by the Los Angeles County Chief Executive Office in connection with that Office's direction of the Museum's temporary caretaking of the boxes and other storage containers, on behalf of myself and any tribal or other organization I represent, I acknowledge and agree as follows:

- I acknowledge that access to the area of the Museum in which the boxes and other containers are located is limited and is reached through a pathway that is not designed for handicapped or public accessibility, including via a steep stairway/ladder. I agree that I will not be able to access that location unless I have appropriate shoes and other protective clothing and am able to walk and climb to and from the non-public area.

- I agree to follow the directions of the Chief Executive Office and the Museum concerning my visit to the location, including concerning the number of people who will be provided access, the length of time access will be provided, and what activities may be permitted during the visit. Specifically, I acknowledge that the location is in a confined area of the Museum and that I cannot handle, open or move any of the boxes or other storage containers or have any open flame or burn any material during my visit. The visit will be no longer than 15 minutes and only non-perishable items will be allowed to be placed on the shelves in the temporary storage area. I acknowledge that **no photography or filming will be permitted**. The human remains are stored in sturdy storage boxes and other protective containers. Due to the extremely fragile nature of these materials, it will not be possible to handle or remove the materials from their containers.

- I acknowledge that the Museum is a temporary caretaker of the boxes and other storage containers and their contents, is acting solely on behalf of and as directed by the Los Angeles County Chief Executive Office, and does not have any legal interest in or right of possession to the boxes and other storage containers and their contents and is not responsible for compliance with any management or disposition requirements for the contents.

- I understand that any questions, concerns or other communications about the boxes and other storage containers or their contents, including the Museum's temporary caretaking, should be directed to the Chief Executive Office, not to the Museum or its staff, which has no responsibility for determining their management, disposition or compliance with applicable laws or regulations.

- I hereby release the County of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History, the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History Foundation, and their respective officers, employees, agents and assignees from any claims or damages, including without limitation from any injury to myself or others or any damage to the boxes and other storage containers or their contents, related to the Museum's temporary caretaking of the boxes and other storage containers or their contents or related to the Museum's and the Chief Executive Office's providing access to the non-public areas within the Museum.
